Registration Information

Welcome

Thank you for your interest in registering your child for the 2009-2010 Kedron Cheerleading season. We are a competition cheerleading team that does not have try-outs. Our motto "EVERYONE CHEERS," is the belief that Kedron Cheerleading was founded upon.

Our Season

The Kedron Cheerleading season is an **8-month commitment**. Our season begins with a one-week mandatory Kedron Camp at the end of August, followed by twice a week practices, every Tuesday night and Saturday morning (including Christmas break) beginning the first week of September. The competition season begins in January, where our teams compete every Saturday or Sunday throughout January, February and March. Additionally, our Midget, Junior and Senior squads compete in a weekend-long Nationals competition in March. During previous seasons we've traveled to Washington, DC and Wildwood, NJ for this competition.

It's important that all cheerleaders and families recognize the commitment required for competition cheerleading. In addition to attendance at every practice and competition, we ask that families avoid scheduling vacations January through March. This is critical because in order to compete and perform the routines, every cheerleader is needed.

Fees

Kedron Youth Association registration is as follows:

\$50 family registration fee, this is per family

\$50 sport fee, this is a per child fee

In addition to the registration fees listed above, cheerleading has additional costs including: competition fees, uniform fees, gym fees and Kedron Camp. Combined, these fees total approximately \$250. Additionally, cheerleaders on the Midget, Junior and Senior squads competing at Nationals have a \$100 competition fee, plus the cost of a hotel. We do our best to fundraise throughout the season to help offset the out-of-pocket costs.

NCA Camp

Cheerleaders age 10 and up are invited to attend a summer camp sponsored by the National Cheerleading Association (NCA) at Millersville University. This camp is not mandatory and is not included in the annual fees listed above.

Kedron Cheerleading Coaches and Board

Kedron Cheerleading is led by an all-volunteer executive board and coaching staff. Each team is assigned a coach and is supported by head moms (dads) and board members. All coaches are certified by NCA.

Parent Meeting

A mandatory parent meeting will be scheduled in the coming weeks to provide additional information about the season and answer any questions. A head mom or a member of the Kedron Cheerleading board will contact you with a date and time for the meeting.
